The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only those items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any item you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and service you selected. This list does not include prices for certain items that you may ask us to buy for you, such as cemetery or crematory services, flowers and newspaper notices. The prices listed on the following pages do not include tax or other cash advance items to be paid to third parties. The prices for those items will be shown on your bill or statement describing funeral goods and services you selected.

Prior to drafting any contract for goods or services, the responsible party or the decedent's survivor who is handling the funeral arrangements is entitled to receive a copy of any preneed agreement in the possession of the funeral establishment that has been signed and paid for, in full or in part, by or on behalf of the decedent.

Basic Services of Funeral Director & Staff\$1255

This is a basic fee we charge every family for our professional expertise in assisting them with their preferences. It includes a proportionate share of the taxes, licenses, insurance, utilities and business expenses required to serve the public. Our charge includes, but is not limited to, preparation of the death certificate for certification by physician or coroner, the necessary permits, filing death certificate with appropriate government agencies (does not include the fees of the government agencies), consultation with cemetery, airlines, crematory, and preparation of obituary notice. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving remains.)

Embalming\$585

Embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement, such as direct cremation or immediate burial, that does not require you to pay for it. Embalming is the disinfection, temporary preservation, and restoration of the body. Embalming allows survivors the time to make unhurried decisions concerning type of service and disposition. It also allows time for relatives and friends to arrive from out of town and permits time for visitation.

Traditional Funeral Service\$3835

Includes basic professional services of funeral director and staff, removal from local place of death, embalming, dressing, casketing, hair dressing, cosmetics, use of facility for visitation, use of facility for funeral service, transportation to local cemetery, and use of flower car. Price does not include third party charges, state filing fee, merchandise, or sales tax on merchandise.

Receiving Remains from Another Funeral Home\$1980

Price includes removal of remains from the Sacramento airport, basic services of funeral director and staff, and funeral coach to local cemetery. Price does not include, refrigeration/embalming, sales tax, state filing fee, or other merchandise.

Forwarding of Remains to Another Funeral Home\$1980

Price includes removal of remains from local place of death, dressing, cosmetizing, hairdressing, placing in casket, and basic services of funeral director and staff. Price does not include embalming, transportation to airport, state filing fee, sales tax, or merchandise.

Direct Cremation \$1655 - 2075

Price includes basic services of funeral director and staff, transfer of remains to funeral home from local place of death, transportation to and from crematory, and crematory charge. This charge does not include viewing of remains, funeral ceremony, embalming/refrigeration, alternative container (unless specified below), urn, sales tax, state filing fee, or any other service. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are made of fiberboard or cardboard.

Immediate Burials \$2090 - 2400

Includes transfer of remains to funeral home from local place of death, basic services of funeral director and staff, dressing, casketing, and delivery to local cemetery. This price does not include other merchandise, sales tax, viewing of remains, funeral ceremony, embalming/refrigeration, state filing fee, or any other service the family may choose. The minimum container provided by the funeral home for an Immediate Burial is constructed of a wooden bottom with heavy cardboard sides and top and nylon handles. Other caskets may be chosen from the Casket Price List.
